### Why it's good ?

Because it is concentrated, finely oaked, well balanced, elegant, traditional but certainly not old-fashioned.

### Good to know

Château Bardins (like Château Frédignac) recently obtained ISO 14001 certification. It means that the Château is strongly involved in a procedure to minimize the footprint on the air, soil, fauna and flora. At Château Bardins, it notably means integral soil tillage, no use of any weed killer. Sulphur, copper and herbal plants tisanes are used to protect the vines.
